I do not have the information contained in those pages; so some other person has seen the "D"

2) Kenneth Thomson of Cross Plains, TN, said that William Gleaves' middle initial is not "D" as most of our records show. He does not think William had a middle initial, but William did have a nephew named William D. Gleaves.

3) Dennis Glaves (p.89 of his book) does not show William with an initial.
